- Pre** Joh 1:12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, *even* to them that believe on his name:

How to Memorize and Retain

1. Read aloud the 5 assigned verses separately 5 times in the morning , and 5 times in the evening.
2. Repeat this procedure for 7 days.
3. Each time before reading Scripture verse repeat book , chapter, and verse.
4. The key thought before the Scripture must be memorized. 5. After completing one assignment per week for 12 weeks, there should be four weeks of reviewing each of the 12 assignments once a day before beginning the 12 assignments in the next section
